

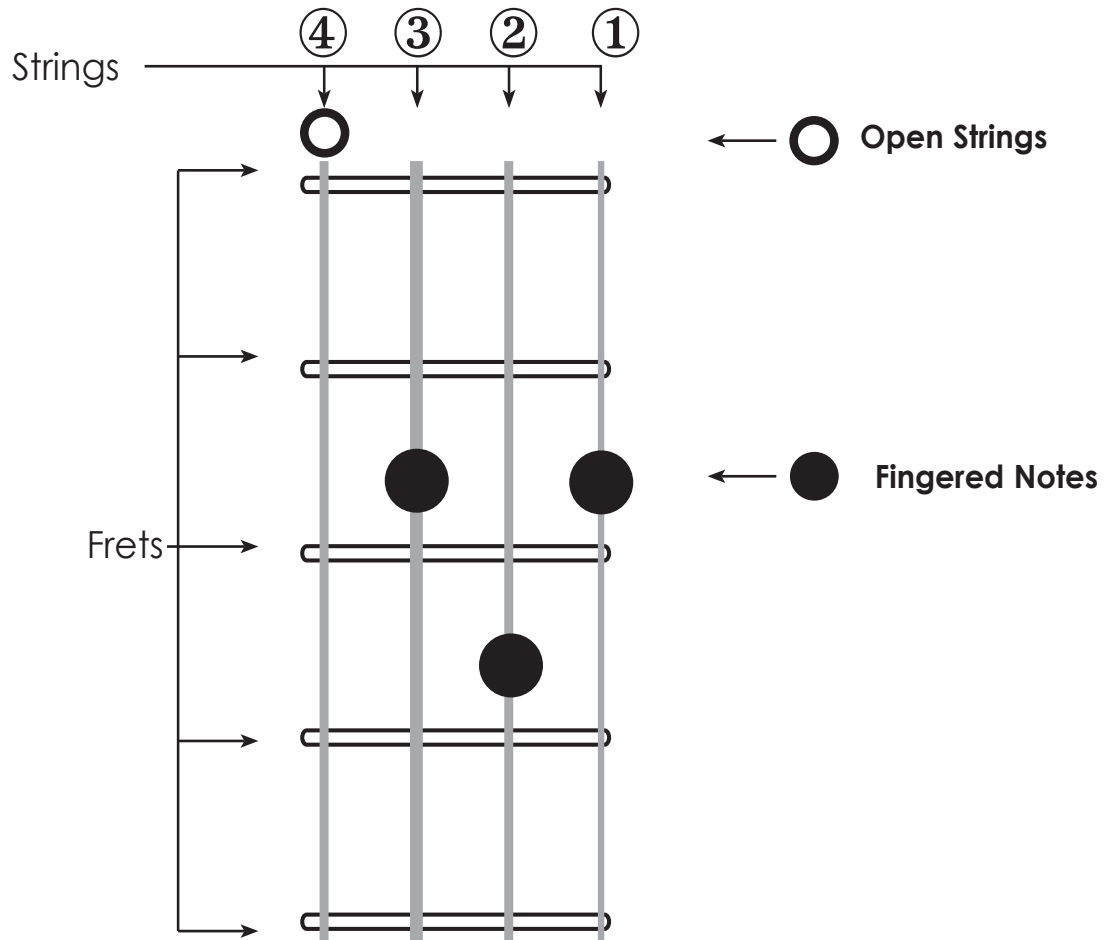

# Basic Ukulele, Ukulele Chords - "C" Tuning (G C E A), High or Low G

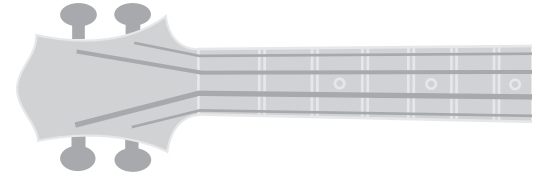

## Basic Chords

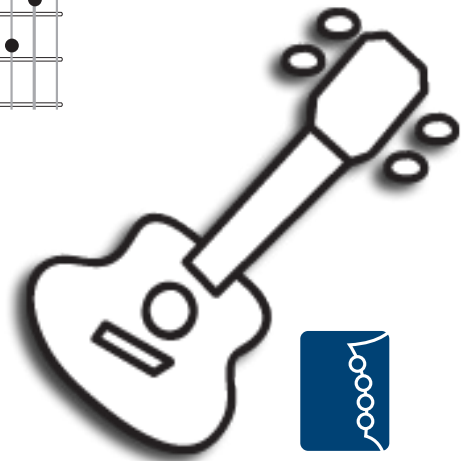
Open Position Chords in Common Keys



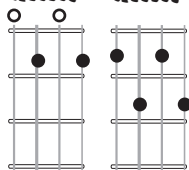
Seventh chords can show up in any of these common keys with any root (letter name of chord).

Chords with no open position voicing are shown in their movable form.

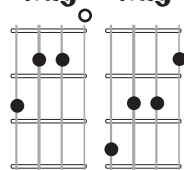

A diminished seventh (dim7, °7) chord can be played in place of a diminished chord
